TO: ALL NASHVILLE INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT AIR CARRIERS

In accordance with the United States Department of Transportation Federal Aviation Administration’s 14 CFR Part 158 regulations governing Passenger Facility Charges (PFC), the Metropolitan Nashville Airport Authority engaged in official consultation with air carriers regarding the approval of PFCs on Wednesday, March 30, 2011 at 10:00 a.m. The meeting took place in the Chamber Room at the offices of MNAA located on the fourth floor of the main terminal building at Nashville International Airport. Subsequent to this consultation PFC Application 17 was submitted and approved by FAA.

The Metropolitan Nashville Airport Authority is requesting an amendment to one of the projects* in Application 17 as follows:

Per the PFC Program, Section 158.3, the Metropolitan Nashville Airport Authority will exclude air carriers with enplaned passengers using air taxis at Nashville International and John C. Tune Airports that:

- have less than one percent (1%) of passenger boardings in the calendar year 2009, or
- have less than 25,000 enplaned passengers in calendar year 2009, or
- provide unscheduled service at Nashville International or John C. Tune Airports

The amendment is necessary due to the fact that the negotiated fee amount for the PCI Airfield Inspection project was higher than anticipated and will increase the proposed PFC impose/use revenue by \$12,500. There is no change to the charge expiration date; this date remains at March 1, 2017.
