TO: ALL NASHVILLE INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT AIR CARRIERS

In accordance with the United States Department of Transportation Federal Aviation Administration's 14 CFR Part 158 regulations governing Passenger Facility Charges (PFC), the Metropolitan Nashville Airport Authority will engage in official consultation with air carriers regarding the approval of PFCs on Thursday, January 14, 2010, at 11:30 a.m. The meeting will take place in the Board Room at the offices of MNAA located on the fourth floor of the main terminal building at Nashville International Airport.

There will be 12 projects that will be presented for amendment from a prior application:

1. Security Checkpoint – Design & Construction
2. Terminal Renovation
3. Reconstruct Taxiway Bravo South - Design
4. Reconstruct Taxiway Alpha South - Design
5. Outbound Baggage Conveyor System – Design & Construction
6. Access Control System Replacement
7. Construct 2L-20R Runway Safety Area
8. Pavement Management and Modification of Standards Identification Study
9. Runway Weather Information System (RWIS)
10. Construct 2R-20L Runway Safety Area
11. Land Acquisition for Elm Hill Pike
12. Aircraft Flight Track Monitoring System

Per the PFC Program, Section 158.3, the Metropolitan Nashville Airport Authority will exclude air carriers with enplaned passengers using air taxis at Nashville International and John C. Tune Airports that:

- have less than one percent (1%) of passenger boardings in the calendar year 2008, or
- have less than 25,000 enplaned passengers in calendar year 2008, or
- provide unscheduled service at Nashville International or John C. Tune Airports

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
