Nashville Airport Authority Promotes Aaron Evans to Assistant Director of Operations

A certified member of the American Association of Airport Executives, Evans is currently enrolled in the Global Airports Council International - International Civil Aviation Organization Airport Management Professional Accreditation Programme and is pursuing accreditation with that organization as an International Airport Professional.

Evans holds a bachelor’s degree in technical aeronautics from Tennessee State University.
