Nashville International Airport Extends Free Parking Offer in Long Term B Through March 7

NASHVILLE, Tenn. — Nashville International Airport (BNA) has extended one free day of parking in Long Term B lot through Sunday, March 7. As a result of construction on a new consolidated rental car facility, a portion of Long Term A parking lot will be permanently closed; but visitors can park in the new Long Term B lot, which is located less than a mile and just minutes from the terminal building. Visitors are urged to use the Donelson Pike exit 216B, as the most direct way to get from I-40 and access the Long Term B and Economy parking lots.

BNA is also currently accepting valid parking coupons from other parking areas. Valid coupons from any airport-area parking lots will be honored and applied toward parking fees accrued when customers utilize any of BNA's parking lots. Upon exiting the airport, customers should present a valid coupon along with an airport parking stub, and a cashier will adjust the fee accordingly. Valid coupons can be applied toward parking fees accrued in airport parking lots. Limit one coupon per visit.

CONRAC Background

The Metropolitan Nashville Airport Authority started construction of a new 900,000 square-foot consolidated rental car facility, or CONRAC, on Feb. 22. CONRAC will be located in BNA's current Long Term A lot, adjacent to the north side of the existing short-term parking garage. When construction is complete, rental car companies will be relocated from the short-term garage and terminal areas to the new facility – a move that will free up an additional 600 covered parking spaces in the current short-term garage for BNA patrons. The new rental car facility has a projected opening date of November 2011.
