## **Southwest Airlines Making Schedule Changes**

NASHVILLE, Tenn. – Southwest Airlines has notified Nashville International Airport (BNA) of several flight adjustments to its current and winter schedules.

“The new nonstop service to Fort Myers and additional service to several markets are positive changes for passengers and the community and serve to enhance the Nashville Airports Experience,” said Raul Regalado, president and CEO of the Metropolitan Nashville Airport Authority, which owns and operates Nashville International.

Southwest will be adding flights with new nonstop service to Fort Myers, Fla., and additional flights to other existing markets during its winter schedule, which runs Jan. 9, 2011, through April 30, 2011.

Fort Myers (RSW) - from 0 daily flights to 2  
Baltimore (BWI) - from 6 to 7  
Orlando (MCO) - from 4 to 5  
Phoenix (PHX) - from 2 to 3

**Reduction:**

Las Vegas (LAS) - from 3 to 2

**Current Schedule Changes:**

Southwest Airlines announced seasonal changes to five flights from Nashville. Effective now through Oct. 30, 2010, Southwest has reduced the following markets by one daily flight.

Chicago (Midway) (MDW) – from 8 daily flights to 7  
New Orleans (MSY) – from 3 to 2  
Orlando (MCO) – from 5 to 4  
Phoenix (PHX) – from 3 to 2  
San Diego (SAN) – from 2 to 1
