

Safely Dispose Of Your Old and Unused Medicine

*Helpful information from the Tennessee Department
of Environment and Conservation*

Acceptable items include:

- Prescription medications
- All over-the-counter medications
- Pet medications
- Medicated ointment, lotions or drops
- Liquid medications in leak-proof containers
- Inhalers
- Pills in any packaging, including glass, plastic container, baggie (Ziploc) or foil

Items not accepted include:

- Illegal drugs & narcotics
- Needles/sharps or syringes with needles
- Blood sugar equipment
- Thermometers
- IV bags
- Bloody or infectious waste
- Personal care products (shampoo, lotions, etc.)

Keep in mind:

- Keep medications in original container if possible
- Cross out name and address
- Do **NOT** cross out the name of the medication
